

Haywood County - Education



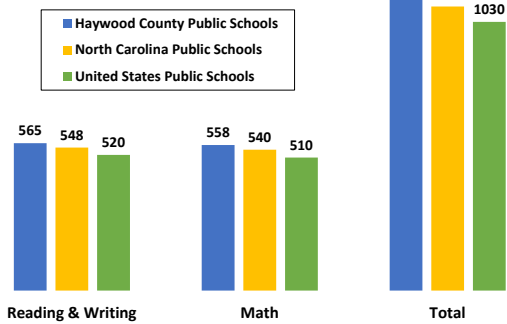
Haywood County is home to fifteen public schools, one charter school, five private schools and a community college. Total student enrollment equals 9,115.

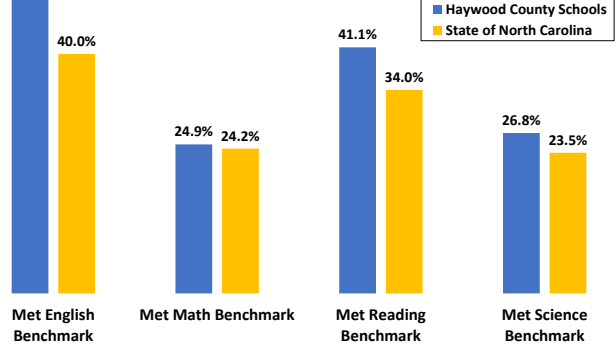
