Haywood County is a vibrant, growing community in the mountains of Western North Carolina, offering abundant amenities to a diversity of residents and visitors.

Location

- A short driving distance to five different states, two international airports, four regional airports and three state capitals.
- o Within an 8-hour drive of 66.8 million Americans and 28.7 million households.

Education

- Home to fifteen public schools, one charter school, five private schools and a community college.
- Local area offers two state public universities, two public community colleges and three private not-for-profit colleges.

Housing

- Total housing stock of nearly 35,000 residential housing units.
- Average of \$23.3 million is invested each quarter in new and upgraded housing, adding an average of 57 new homes quarterly.
- An average of 330 home sales close each quarter, while roughly 230 homes are available for sale.

Population

- o A total population of 62,089, projected to add 5,842 new residents by 2030.
- More than 26,600 households comprised of 17,170 families and 4,566 persons choosing to live alone.

- Total workforce of slightly more than 29,000.

- Home to portions of the Pisgah National Forest, Shining Rock Wilderness Area, Blue

- o Four golf courses, a ski area, several museums, theaters and movie houses.

- Home to a 155-bed regional hospital, a walk-in clinic, two urgent care centers and a hospice & palliative care center.
